

REQUIRED SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Grade Four 2008-2009

- 1 Country Day School Assignment Notebook
- 1 (1 ½ in.) zippered 3 ring binder for folders
- 1 sturdy zippered pouch for pencils/crayons
- 6 black and white copy books (college rule)
- 1 black and white (large, bound) 1/4 " "graph" notebook for math (School store)
- 6 sturdy pocket folders (no paper) with holes for binder
- 2 red marking pens
- 1 standard/Metric ruler
- 1 container of Elmer's Glue and a large glue stick
- 1 pair of **serious** scissors
- 1 set of crayons
- 1 set of colored pencils (Science and Spanish)
- 1 Rand McNally Atlas - available only in School Store
- 1 pink eraser
- 2 highlighters
- 20 #2 pencils – with student's initials
- 1 hand held pencil sharpener with cover
- 1 box of tissues with child's name
- Microwave supplies- small 8 in. plates, forks, and spoons (1 box of each)
- 1 box of quart sized Ziploc bags

At the 4-6th grade level, a great deal of dictionary work is done. An Intermediate level home dictionary will be most valuable. Please avoid Pocket editions.

- **Required SUMMER READING BOOKS for the First Day of School**
- **Required for Art:** One soft "drawing" pencils - #3B, 1 unmarked pink eraser, 1 medium-fine, water base black markers as well as basic, home art supplies. A blank Art Journal (as in 3rd grade) is optional
- **Required for Computer:** Please see reverse side.
- **Required for PE:** Uniform, sneakers, and water jug/bottle
- **Required for Handbells** – Master Theory Book (available in school store)
- Optional for Spanish: **Vox Spanish & English Dictionary** (Available in School Store)
- Optional - Swing-line stapler and pencil sharpener

Except for Art group supplies, students are urged to mark their name on all property with a permanent marker. Supplies may need to be replaced during the year.

Requirements for COMPUTER: Grades 4-6

1. E-mail account accessible via a website

Students must have an active, Internet accessible e-mail account, which will be needed in class and for homework. Even if parents do not have Internet at home, they can create such an account in the computer lab, library, or public library. Additionally, adequate time will be allotted for students to complete their assignments in the computer lab outside of class time, i.e. recess, before school, after school, etc. The Lower School Computer teacher's e-mail address, jgarren@stxcountryday.com should be added to the address book or contact list. Please feel free to contact Mr. Garren if you have any questions. Mr. Garren is also willing to set up an account for your child, but to do so, a note is required from the parents giving him permission to do this.

2. Folder with pockets

Each student should bring a folder for computer class. This will be to store work they need to bring to class and printed out material they will need to retain for the course.

3. (optional) storage device

- USB Flash Drive
