Requirements for **COMPUTER**: Grade 4

1. **E-mail account accessible via a website**

Students must have an active, Internet accessible e-mail account, which will be needed in class and for homework. Additionally, adequate time will be allotted for students to complete their assignments in the computer lab outside of class time, i.e. recess, before school, after school, etc.
