

## REQUIRED SCHOOL SUPPLIES

### GRADE SIX

2011-2012

*All supplies should be labeled with student name*

**Students must have supplies for Registration Day**

- 1 Sturdy zippered pouch for pencils/pens (CDS model has proven durable)
- 7 wide ruled composition notebooks
- 2 composition, 1/4 inch "graph" notebook for math (School Store)
- 1 Trapper Keeper with folders/pockets for each subject (6)
- 1 Country Day Assignment Notebook (available at the School Store)
- 1 Glue Stick
- 1 Red pen
- 1 Yellow highlighter
- 1 Pair of "serious" scissors
- 1 Set (8) of colored pencils (not crayons)
- 1 Set of 8 markers (thick or thin)
- 2 Ballpoint pens with eraser (Black or Blue only)
- 1 Fine point waterproof drafting pen (Pilot, rolling ball or something similar)
- 1 Special Compass (found only in CDS School Store) and 1 clear protractor
- 1 Rand McNally World Atlas (most recent publication, available only in School Store)
- A good supply of #2 pencils (No mechanical pencils, please)
- 2 Pink pearl erasers
- "Book Sox" or other sturdy cover for at least two large textbooks
- Required PE Uniform and Water Jug
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 packages 3X3 post-its
- 2 package of lined loose leaf paper

#### **Required:**

**ART:** One soft 'drawing" pencil - #3B to #6B; one kneaded gray eraser, one pink pearl eraser, one fine waterproof drafting pen (Sakura pigment #5 is best; Pilot rolling ball is fine), as well as basic home, art supplies. Pencils, erasers and pens should be unmarked as they are pooled for class supplies. A 6"x 9" Art Sketchbook (available at School store) **is optional**.

**COMPUTER:** USB flash drive

child accessible internet based e-mail account

**BAND:** instrument, "**Essential Elements, Book I, 2000**," pocket folder

**CHORUS:** pocket folder

#### **Optional:**

- 1. Vox Spanish & English Dictionary. (Available in School Store)
- 2. Stapler and staples (full sized model works best)
- 3. 1 Calculator - Basic Functions (Avoid Scientific Calculators)

#### **Notes:**

- 1. At the 6<sup>th</sup> grade level, a great deal of dictionary work is done. A **collegiate level** home dictionary is essential.
- 2. Supplies do run out and will need to be replaced. Students will need to have all items listed available throughout the year.

**Extra or unnecessary "stuff" interferes with the student's ability to organize efficiently. Rule of thumb: if it's not on the Supply List, your child doesn't need it at school!**
